## Eco-Products International Fair 2005

### Ajinomoto Thailand Company Promotes Efforts to “Make the World Green”

FD Green (Thailand) Co., Ltd., a group company of Ajinomoto Co., (Thailand) Ltd., participated in the Eco-Products International Fair 2005 held from October 6th to 10th in Bangkok, Thailand. This annual fair is organized by the Asian Productivity Organization (APO) in collaboration with related organizations in host countries <sup>(\*)</sup> since 2004 to exhibit green products and initiatives in Asia, where environmental awareness has been increasing recently.

This year, more than 4,000 people attended the fair and 55 companies and organizations including 21 Japanese firms participated to introduce their environmentally friendly products and their environmental efforts such as energy saving and recycling.

It is the second time for the Ajinomoto Group to participate in the fair, as Ajinomoto (Malaysia) Berhad joined the last year's fair held in Malaysia. Engaged in processing the by-products from the amino-acid fermentation and seasoning plants under the Ajinomoto Co., (Thailand) Ltd. to produce value-added fertilizers, FD Green presented the Ajinomoto Group's environmental policy and efforts in the exhibition. Focusing on the *Bio-cycle*, the Ajinomoto Group's recycling-oriented production process to utilize such nutrient-enriched by-products for the cultivation of sugarcanes and cassavas used for producing amino-acid, the exhibition attracted a great deal of attentions throughout the event.
